

Your new Neighbor, Planned Parenthood

What can you expect from your new neighbor?



Planned Parenthood:

- is America's largest abortion provider. They committed 264,943 abortions in 2005. *Planned Parenthood Annual Report 2005-2006.*
- is equipped to perform 9,000 abortions per year at their new building, 3051 E. New York Street in Aurora.
Estimate based on statistics from existing Planned Parenthood abortion facilities and a description of the Aurora facility in the Aurora Beacon, August 22, 2007.
- recommends sexually explicit materials for children as young as nine years old. *E.g., "Focus on Kids," ETR Associates, 2005.*
- provides sex-ed materials to children that are far too graphic even to be described in this newspaper.
- strongly opposes proven-effective abstinence education programs. *Planned Parenthood Fact Sheet, "Abstinence-Only Programs," June 2007.*
- distributes condoms, birth control pills and abortion drugs to teens without parental knowledge or consent.

Does Planned Parenthood respect parents and families?

Planned Parenthood:

- wants teenage girls to be able to get abortions without consulting with their parents. They fight parental notification laws across the country. *E.g., Ayotte v Planned Parenthood of Northern New England, 2006.*
- encourages sex before marriage: "S-E-X: It's that three-letter word that can be fun to do and can feel great." *Planned Parenthood's website for teens, www.teenwire.com.*
- has a long track record of shielding child predators from the law, despite their obligation as legally mandated sexual abuse reporters. *Life Dynamics: www.childpredators.com.*
- is anti-child. A Planned Parenthood ad proclaimed, "Babies are loud, smelly and expensive."

Planned Parenthood:

- applied for permits for the Aurora abortion clinic under the name Gemini Office Development, listing their tenant as "unknown"—a lie.
- allowed the City of Aurora to believe a quiet medical facility was moving in, when they knew it would be the largest abortion clinic in the country—a lightning rod of controversy.
