Worldwide evidence gives hope to premature baby's father



A premature baby of 27 week was spontaneously aborted on three months ahead of the Expected Delivery Date (EDD) on January 1, 2010 and weighed 840 gm. The father and mother said, "We had only a slim hope that our baby would survive". The father of the baby added "I was aware of another similar case who has survived. So, I came to the doctors of the OM Hospital and Research Center of Katmandu (The hospital where 1st test tube baby of Nepal was successfully survived) and shared this information with the doctors. But the doctors brushed aside my optimism and said the case could be possible only in developed country having modern equipment". Even though, the doctors kept the baby at neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) said Deepak Parajuli the father of the baby.

Dr. Rita Singh Said "We faced hardships for balancing every element to make the child survive" we worked on the theory '**hoping against the hope**' for making the child survive and at last, it turned out to be miraculous". "Before the baby was 840gm. only but now he is 1920gm.

Dr. Hari Kishor Shrestha, managing director of the hospital, said "survival of the premature child is the first ever case in the history of the hospital." He added that the child could adapt successfully to the external environment and the baby boy would be discharged from the hospital tomorrow (27th. Feb. 2010)

Dr. Bhola Rijal, chairperson of the hospital, claimed that it was for the first time in the country's history that the premature-born baby survived. The premature-born baby normally can not adopt the environment and die but the child is easily adopting in the external environment, he added.
